Deadline for portfolio and applications for AY 2026-27 is Monday May 4, 2026.

No late submissions will be accepted.

Accepted students are expected to complete their advanced BFA in Art degree requirements at CSI. In the penultimate semester students take ART 390 and ART 401, and in the final semester, ART 480.
