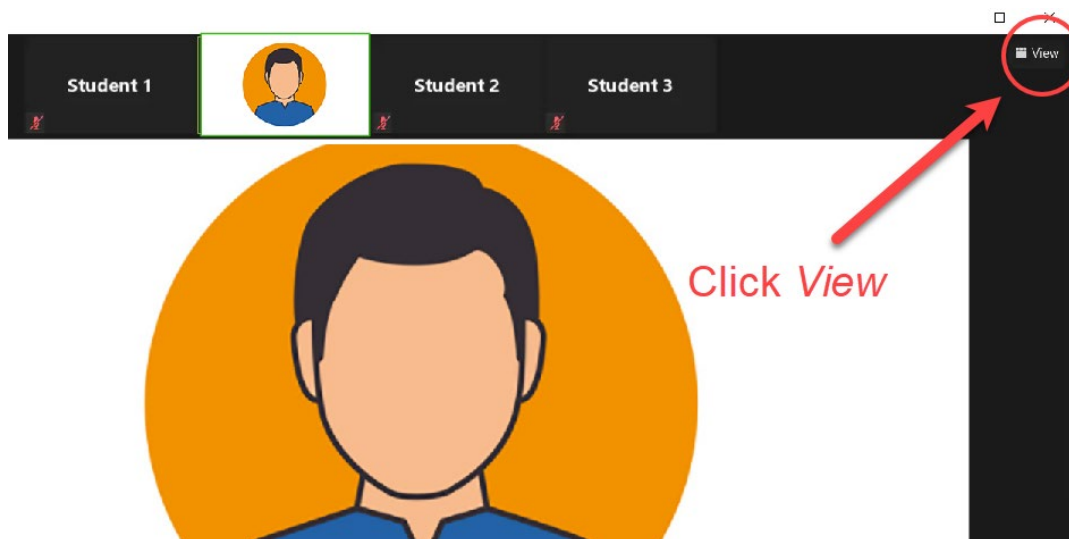


Views in Zoom

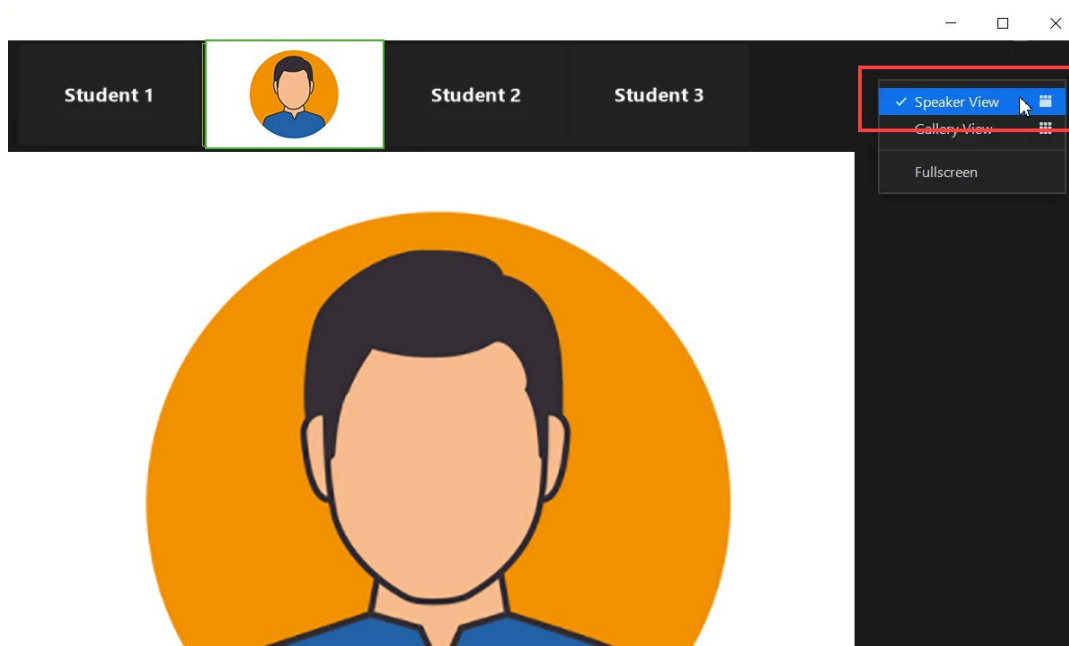
In a Zoom meeting you have a number of ways of arranging the presentation and participant display windows.

To change your view in Zoom, click *View* in the top right of screen.



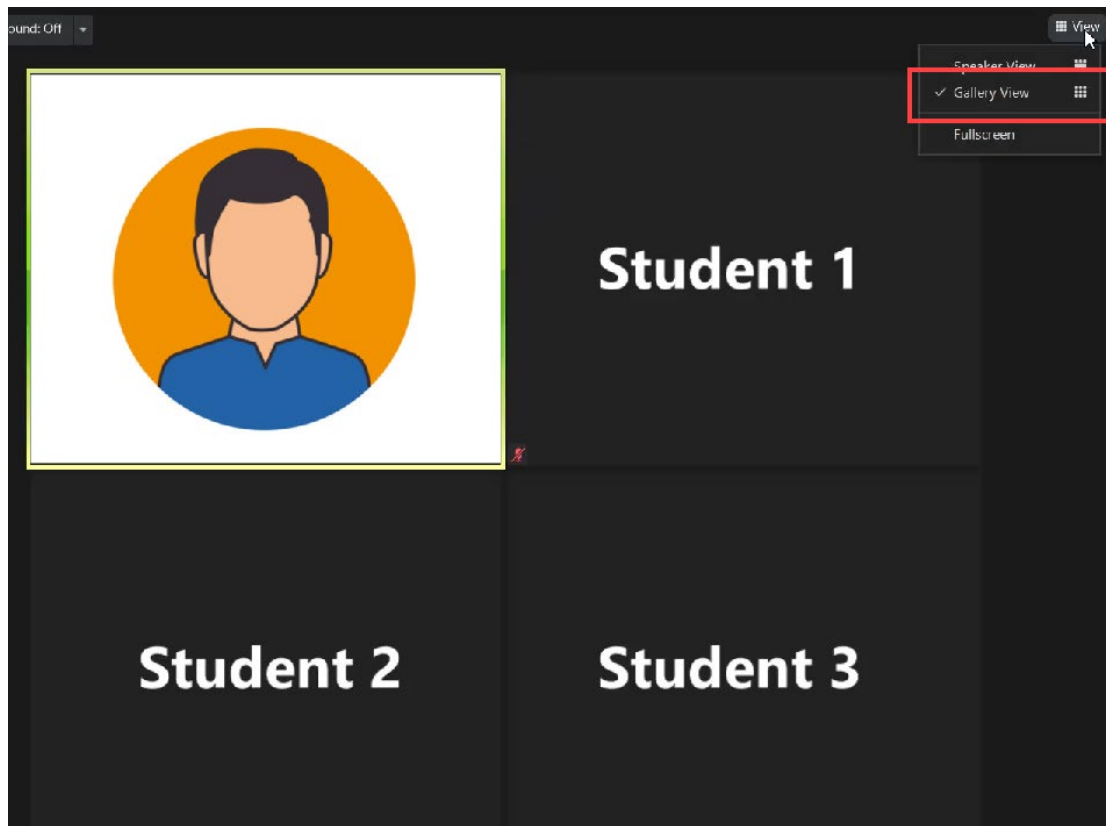
Speaker View

In *Speaker View* the participants are displayed along the top of screen, whoever is currently talking with their mic active will be highlighted.



Gallery View

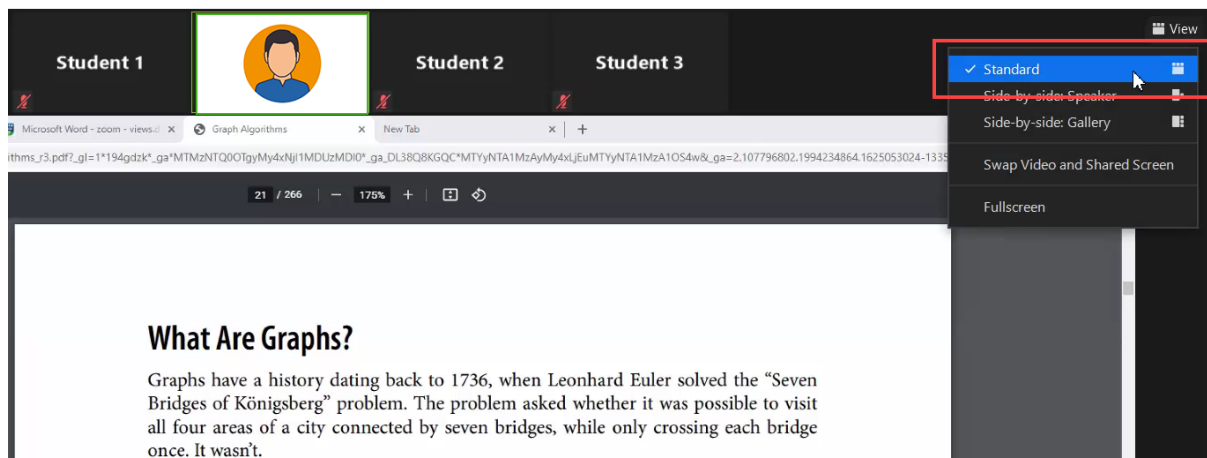
In *Gallery View* the screen is divided into a grid and shared among participants equally.



When your lecturer is sharing their screen you have additional display options.

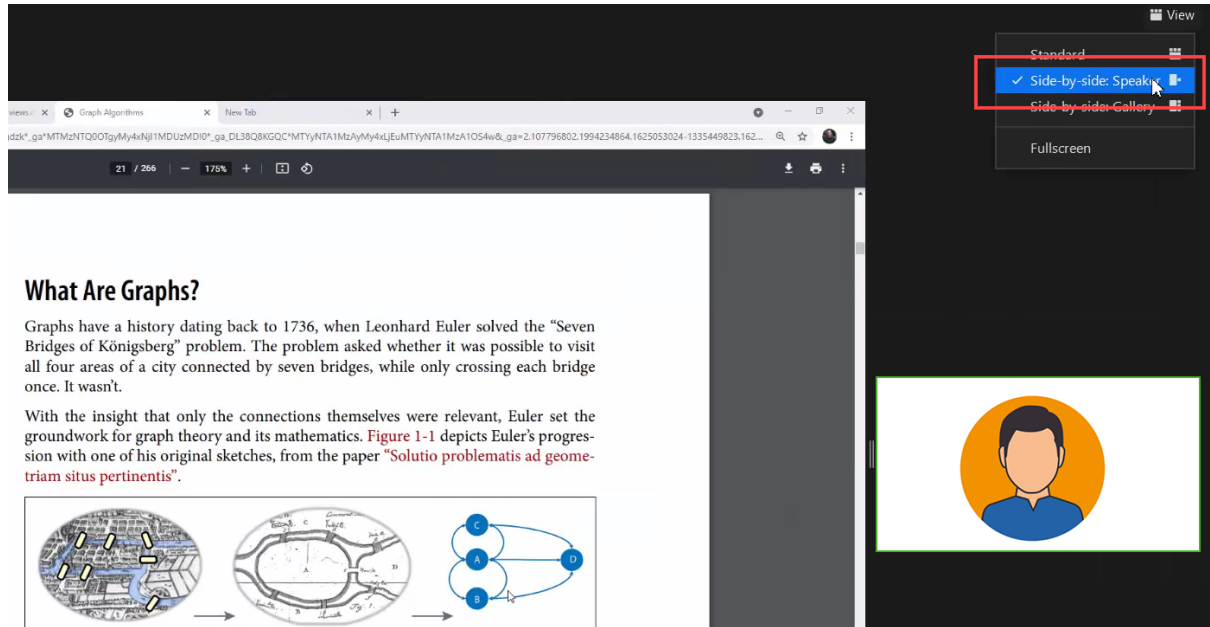
Standard View

In *Standard view* the presentation window is highlighted and the participants are arranged along the top of the screen.



Side-by-side Speaker View

In *Side-by-side Speaker* view the presentation window is highlighted and displays on the right while the presenter window is displayed on the left.



Side-by-side Gallery View

In *Side-by-side Gallery* view the presentation window is highlighted and displays on the right while the participant windows are displayed on the left.
